the success of his clients with three out of four finishing in the money.

The competition was also a chance for the abattoir to gauge breeders' flock lambing percentages.

This year's average 108pc lamb marking was the same as the previous year but showed more Merino ewes achieving a higher percentage with 67pc achieving more than 100pc (compared with 41pc the previous year) and non-pure Merinos showing a drop from 93pc achieving 100pc to only 85pc achieving more than 100pc lambs.

Data showing the range of lamb marking emphasised the detrimental effect of brucellosis on lambing results with one infected flock achieving only 57pc at marking while the best performance was 143pc.
