consignments above 300 lambs sections or all sections if applicable.

The latter of the two sections were introduced last year and have proved popular with competition participants.

The same weight and fat grid has been used since 2006 and the WAMMCO Select lean meat yield grid was used for bonus and discount points with the average carcase weight recording 23kg with a fat score of 2.80 and 49.7pc yield.

Numbers were well up from the competition's previous record of 21,000 entries.

Lambs were received from throughout the state including Walkaway, Mingenew, Beacon, Esperance, Manjimup and Donnybrook and places in between.

Broken down, 33pc of the entries came from the Great Southern, 28pc the Wheatbelt and 16pc from the South West.
